Minimal Qualifications:

- Active Christian faith
- At least two years of college completed & 20 years of age (Preferable 21 or older)
- Ability and desire to learn, perform, and teach certain outdoor skills and activities (i.e. fire building, rock climbing, canoeing, etc.)
- Ability to perform potentially strenuous physical activities (hiking, spelunking, rafting, etc.)
- Comfortable with building Christian community by leading, teaching and equipping others
- Ability to work well with others
- Desire to be outdoors for extended period of time and instill that admiration in youth
- Creativity and problem solving skills in all types of high-stress and fast-paced situations

General and Specific Responsibilities:

- Supervising campers
 - Personally responsible for up to twelve campers each week alongside co-counselor
 - Partner with fellow counselors and campers for all activities throughout the week
 - Oversee camper safety and well-being
 - o Tend to campers' individual abilities and health issues
 - o Daily cleaning (shelters, bathrooms, trash, dishes, kitchen, etc.)
 - Belay at challenge course and on off site trips for campers
- Upholding Adventure Camp Philosophy
 - Encourage and practice small group camping as detailed in Adventure Camp staff training
 - Regard safety as the first priority and most important consideration in every activity and action
 - Emphasize intentionality in spiritual growth and development
- Training
 - Lifeguard Certification
 - o Potential skills: canoeing, climbing, belaying, backpacking, etc.
 - o Trip logistics: schedules, safety, camper trip orientation, etc.
 - Community development (team building)
 - o Outdoor skills: fire making, shelter building, cooking, purifying water, etc.
 - "Leave No Trace" philosophy
- Implementing the mission of Camp Lake Stephens in the day to day activities of campers
 - Incorporate summer curriculum throughout daily activities and routines
 - Plan and debrief activities to reflect the Gospel and develop character
 - Facilitate and coordinate morning and evening devotions, and cabin devotions, with campers and other counselors
