



SUMMER CAMP INFORMATION FOR PARENTS AND CAMPERS

1. **DROP-OFF INFORMATION:** On-site registration is on Mondays beginning at 2 pm at the Lodge (the building with rocking chairs on the front porch).
2. **FINAL CAMP FEE BALANCES** should be mailed/submitted before drop-off.
3. **THINGS FOR CAMPERS TO BRING:** Campers should bring sleeping bags or linens for a single bed, pillow, towels, personal toiletries, swimwear (girls' suits must cover their midriff), a water bottle (these may be purchased at the camp gift shop), sunscreen, insect spray, a flashlight, and any medications they take on a regular basis (which will be left with the Camp Nurse). Campers must have closed-toed shoes; we suggest campers bring two pairs of shoes for when one gets wet. Campers are encouraged to bring a Bible for daily devotional times.
4. **NOT ALLOWED:** Items not allowed for campers are cell phones, electronic equipment (radios, cd players, DVD players, IPODs, etc.), pets, personal vehicles (for senior high campers), personal sports equipment, pocket-knives, valuable jewelry, or medications except those prescribed and left with the Camp Nurse. Campers are not allowed to have food in the cabins, so please do not send food with your camper. Alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, tobacco products, fireworks and firearms are strictly prohibited.
5. **TALENT SHOW:** Campers may bring clothing or accessories for the Friday night Talent Show. The weekly theme will be included in an email that goes to all camper parents the week before the session.
6. **SNACK SHACK:** The Snack Shack no longer accepts cash for purchases during the week. Please deposit money for snacks in your camper's Online Account. Campers visit the Snack Shack once a day and may only spend up to \$2 on snacks (ice cream, candy, chips, drinks) per day. The Snack Shack also sells Frisbees (\$12) and water bottles (\$10). Other items are available at the camp gift shop (Quay's Place), such as t-shirts, sunglasses, caps, flashlights/lanterns, hammocks, jewelry, stuffed animals, toiletries, and much more. The gift shop will only be open on Drop-Off and Pick-Up days (Store Accounts can NOT be used in gift shop).
7. **PICK-UP INFORMATION:** Camp officially ends Saturday mornings at 10 am. Parents are invited to attend the campers' Closing Celebration. If you wish to attend this closing event, please arrive by 9:20 am, meet in front of the Lodge, where CLS staff members will direct you to the Chapel at the appropriate time.
